

The Destruction of Controlled Drugs is Changing

Why?

A new system of appointing authorised witnesses for the destruction of controlled drugs is being implemented within Lancashire & South Cumbria. Organisations can now apply for their own professionals to be authorised as a witness. This will be for a defined period of time and limited to the premises for which the application relates.

This process is used by the majority of NHS England offices and has created a sustainable and timely system for everyone's mutual benefit.

What we do

- Send you an application form.
- In many cases, authorise a named person to witness the CD destruction in the specified premises.
- Revoke that authorisation after 28 days.
- Monitor requests for CD destruction and drugs destroyed.
- Undertake spot checks.

What you must do

- Request CD destruction on CD tool as usual <u>cdreporting.co.uk.</u>
- Complete short application form.
- Destroy CDs within 28 days.
- Confirm destruction by email.
