The purpose of this communication is to inform you of our free home testing kits to screen for sexually transmitted infections which are available for people of all ages via our service website. The testing kits are available by visiting:

A short online request form is completed enabling a bespoke testing kit to be tailored towards each individual. The kit contains easy to follow instructions on how to collect samples for Chlamydia, Gonorrhoea, HIV and Syphilis. The testing kits are posted in discreet packaging and all postage costs are included. Results will be given within two weeks from return postage to the patients desired contact method i.e. mobile phone, email which is chosen and confirmed on the patient online order request.
