Safer injecting



- Avoid injecting site bacterial infections by washing hands and site before you inject
- Only use new sterile equipment: make sure you always collect enough
- Rotate injecting sites to give your veins a rest
- If an injecting site becomes red or sore, don't inject there - show the infection to your pharmacist, needle exchange or GP
- Citric and vitC damage veins: use as little as possible
- Injecting drugs increases risk of overdose as well as HIV, and hepatitis: smoking drugs reduces the risks
